## **Reports and Old Business**

# 1. Treasurer Report

- The money from the table and chair grant has been deposited
- Current Balance- \$9441.13
- Signing authority is Teresa, Zach, Luke and Sayla
- We can get cheques made, 25 free and and if needed we can get more- Sayla will pick up
- In the future Sayla would like a picture of receipts, and we can still give her physical copy when we see her
- After we pay for the tables and chairs, and screws we will have \$4684.33 remaining

#### 2. Table and chairs

- Quote \$4750 from Canadian tire, 8 foot tables and chairs
- We have a grant for \$2500
- Teresa will watch the Canadian tire flyers for the next few weeks and ask to see if they are going on sale soon
- We do not have to turn in receipts but we do have to promote community futures on webpage and Facebook page

## 3. Fire Suppression Equipment

- Dave will look into fire suppression equipment
- We might store it in the pump shed

#### 4. Fencing Supplies

- Luke has all the rails, posts and gate and they are paid for
- Has ordered the screws, cost \$436.80

 A few days before the fence workbee Luke will go with the skid steer and do the ground work

# 5. Well Drilling

- No phone calls have been made yet about well drilling
- Defer to next meeting

# 6. Playground Equipment

- There are no playground equipment and baseball backstop from he school district
- The city has removed all baseball backstops and none are available
- Anything that the city doesn't have a use for they sell on the site government.deal
- Discussion about whether we would consider building our own baseball backstop, we will bring up again at a later date

#### 7. West Fraser Fundraiser

- Kim has applied but hasn't yet heard back if we have been approved
- If we are approved the deadline for using the 2 tickets worth \$4500 is guite small
- Discussion on putting a plan in place so when and if it is approved we are ready to start
- Printing tickets would probably cost about \$200
- We will sell them for \$20 and only sell 250
- Sayla makes a motion that it would only be president, vice president, treasurer and secretary, of the executive excluded from buying tickets for the draw, directors are eligible to buy tickets; Teresa seconded, All in favour.
- Teresa will oversee the ticket book sales
- Sayla will get the gaming license once we are approved

#### 8. Insurance

- Bouchie lake is in municipal so all their insurance falls under that umbrella
- Mclease lake \$1200 a weekend rental and \$9000 a year for insurance. They have many more amenities than us.
- Teresa will contact Sage Gordon about Baker Creek Insurance
- Hub insurance has been recommended by several associations
- Luke will get quote from Rick Alchtsen at Hub insurance for community insurance, directors insurance, what is recommended for director liability, single event insurance, and archery night insurance
- The most economical way of organizing insurance might be director insurance, having waivers for renters and giving the option of individual event insurance

- Joes will go on the cabinets and Judiths will go outside on the community grounds somewhere
